Mexico and was blessed with seven children. In 1975 she became a widow and was left to raise all her children on her own. Three years after becoming a widow Sis. Gloria migrated to the United States to provide a better life for her and her children. Settling down in Eagle Lake, TX, she lived there for thirteen years and in 1992 relocated to Pasadena, TX where she lived until the Lord called her home.

Sis. Gloria was known as a loving and caring person by everyone who came into contact with her. Regardless of any malice that was done towards her and her family, she was never one to hold a grudge or retaliate. She was known for going above and beyond to be hospitable to anyone who visited her home, making sure that anyone who visited was taken care of and making sure that they were comfortable.
