Her parents were Alice and Harlen Gilbert. She was the first of 2 children. She graduated from high school in Izard County, Arkansas.

Mrs. Beaty worked in the South Houston area as an Educational Aide.

She was married to Homer Louis Beaty in 1950 and thereafter became an Air Force wife, taking on the special responsibility and honor of supporting a nation's hero.

Mrs. Beaty was a member of the Soda Baptist Church. She studied many religions with interest and fervor and did not come upon her convictions by circumstance or by chance, but by well-educated choice and divine guidance. 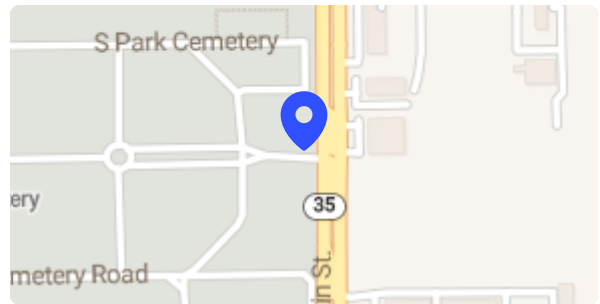

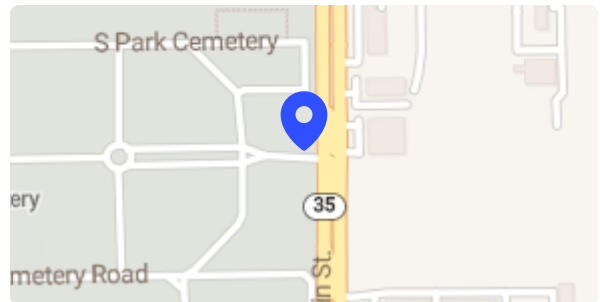
