She was a proud Midterm graduate of Milby High School class of 1954 where she had kept in contact with many of her classmates in the recent years.

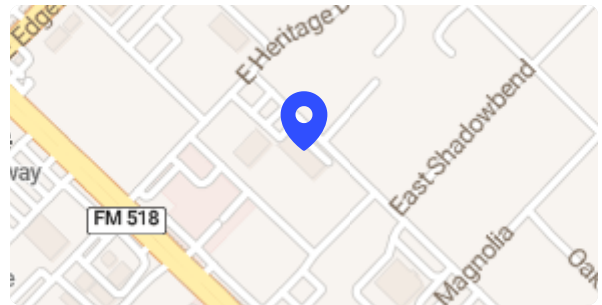

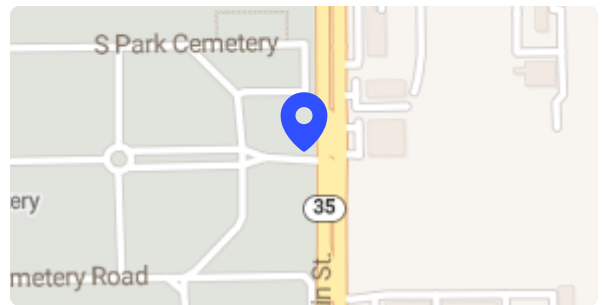
