Ronald Liang Kuan Teo peacefully passed away in his sleep Monday, August 8 after a long battle with cancer. Ronald was 65 years old.

Ronald was born June 25, 1951 in Singapore, Singapore. He was the oldest son of Guan Hui Teo and Swee Har Wong.

After working in Saudi Arabia and Indonesia, Ronald made Houston, Texas his home in 1982. He celebrated his marriage to Clarita Lumabas in 1984.
