He is preceded in death by his parents, Julia and Miguel Cevallos, sister, Anita Cevallos and brother, Jesus Cevallos, Sr.






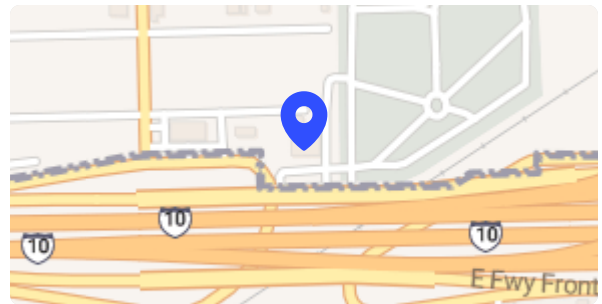
