**M**abel Joyce Landers of Houston, Texas, passed away on Oct. 3, 2018, at the age of 85. She was born July 7, 1933, in Joaquin, Texas, to Willie Joseph and Mellie Evelyn Taylor Anderson.

When Joyce was 16, she met David Earl Landers at a midnight show in Houston. She thought he was the most handsome man she'd ever met, and they were married in 1950. Joyce and David raised five children together, and their love for children helped in their decision to foster 19 babies over a three-year period. They built a pink brick home filled with love, laughter and creativity.

In 1968, Joyce cofounded an answering service that continues to this day as Westpark Communications. Joyce and David later traveled the world and were married for 50 years. She was her happiest dancing, enjoying good food, and spending time with friends and family. Joyce was also a prolific letter writer and was known for her wisdom, her humor, her memory and her kindness.

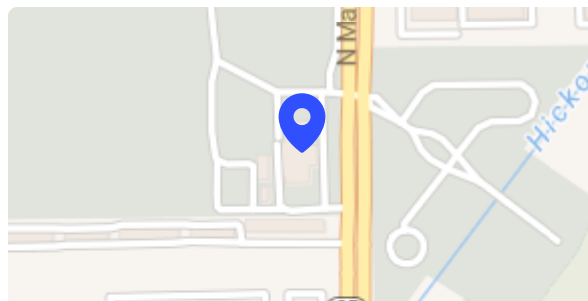

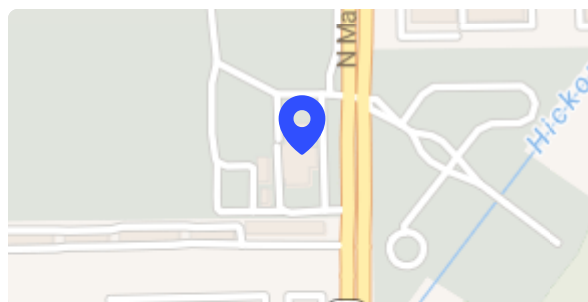

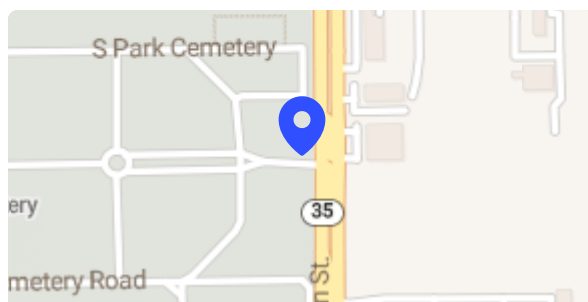
