Paul Ciolli passed away peacefully at home with family. He was born and raised in Youngstown Ohio, the third of seven children. Dad earned a football scholarship to John Carroll University in Cleveland. He was an outstanding center and majored in math. Dad's Army Reserve unit was called to active duty after his sophomore year. He was sent to train at Camp Wallace in Hitchcock and met the love of his life Margaret in Houston. They married at Fort Rucker, Alabama, and he was sent overseas to serve with the 66th Infantry Division in France during World War II. After the war he continued his education at the University of Houston and raised a family of five children. His beloved Margaret passed away in 2011.

Most of Dad's career was in the energy and civil engineering fields, working at Shell Oil Continental Oil and Shaner Hicks & Cherry. After retiring he maintained his surveyor license and continued as a consultant into his 80s.

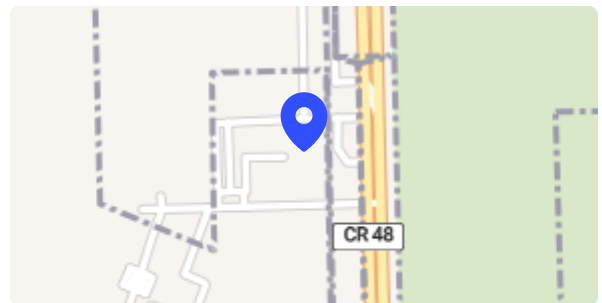

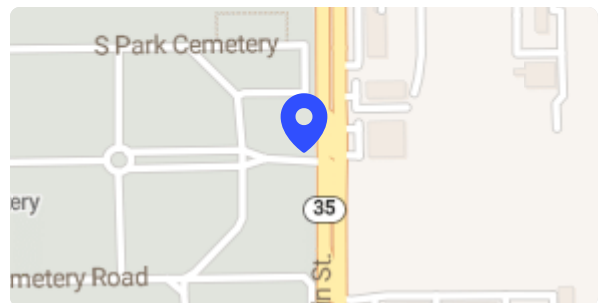
