He became a member of Primera Iglesia Bautista in Austin with the Reverend Carlos Paredes as his Pastor. It was here that he met his soon to be brother-in-law, Reyes Rojas who introduced him to his sister Matilde. They were married on May 19, 1962 at Primera and raised their two daughters with the teachings of the Bible and teachings of the most revered Hno. Paredes.

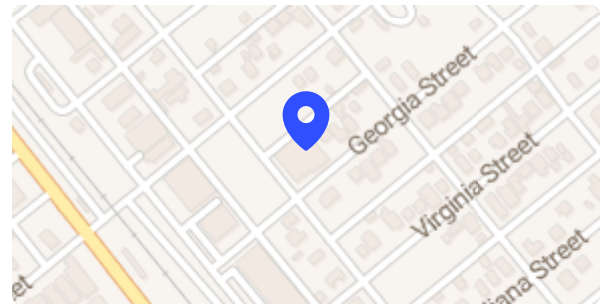

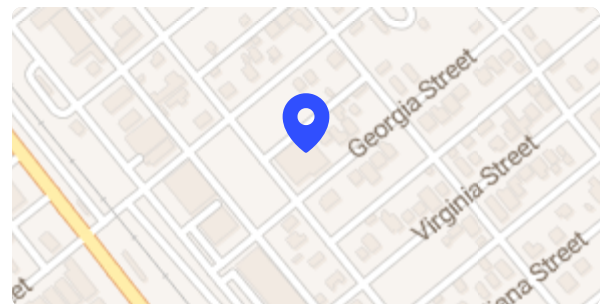

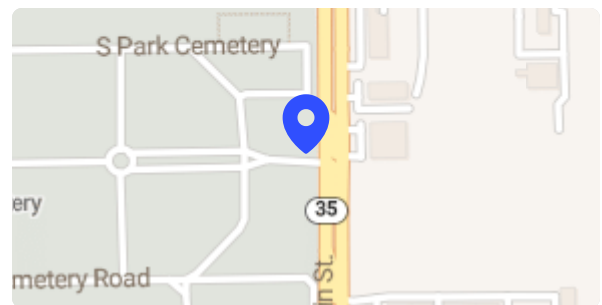
