In January 1993, Salvatore graduated from the Liberty Bible Institute in Lynchburg, Virginia. He was also a Concealed Handgun Instructor. One of his passions was serving The Lord by preaching and leading praise and worship at the Star of Hope Mission in downtown Houston. Salvatore was proud to be an Italian American. His ancestors were immigrants from Sicily, Italy.

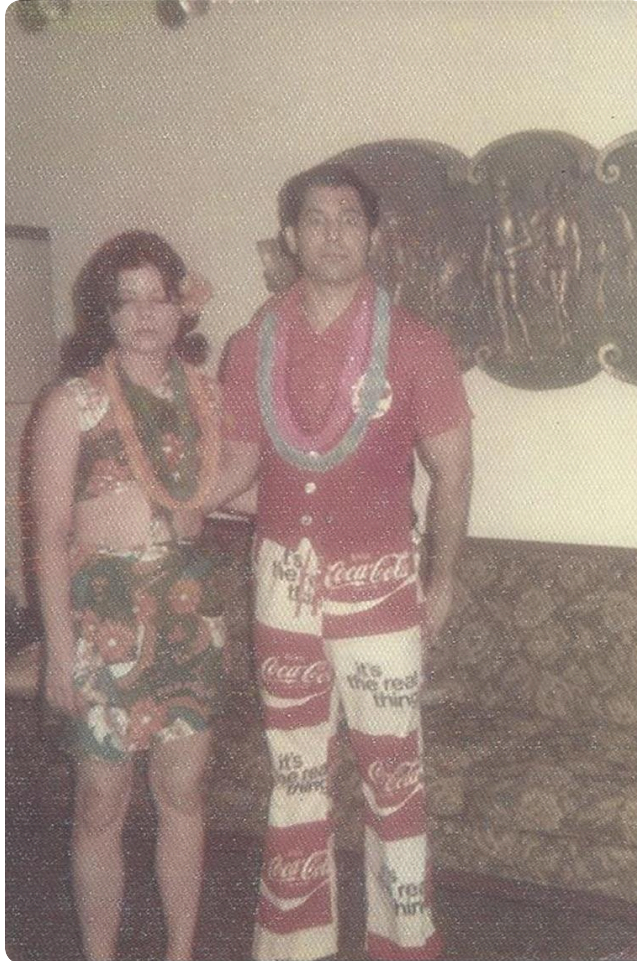

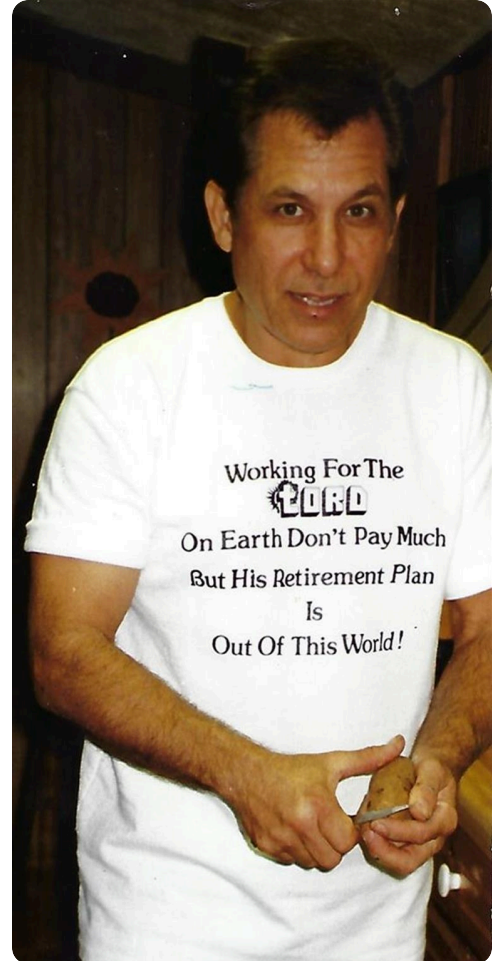
