Born on January 2, 1928, she was welcomed by Anna Marie Johnson (deceased) and William Hamilton Johnson (deceased). Predeceased siblings are Olga Prater, Roland Johnson, Edna McClendon and Patsy Chappell. Surviving siblings are brothers Ralph Johnson and Howard Johnson. Anne married David Norman Weldon (deceased) on September 14, 1946. They had four children, Norma A. W. Fuqua (Royce Owen), Lynn Marie W. Steele (deceased) (John), Carolyn Louise Weldon, and David Weldon (Jerrie). Grandchildren are Jonathan Weldon-Schilling, Amanda Steele Herring (Ryan), Jacquelyn Steele Curfman (Chris), Matthew Weldon, Mark Weldon (Annie), and Michael Weldon. She later opened and ran a kindergarten school until going to work for First State Bank of Edinburg and later First National Bank of Edinburg. In 1972 Anne and Norman Weldon purchased a Mobil Service Station and for some years she did bookkeeping for the business; upon the sale of that business, she was able to spend her time enjoying her children and each and every new grandchild. She ultimately went back to teaching kindergarten at First Baptist Church School until 1994 when they moved to Pearland, Texas.

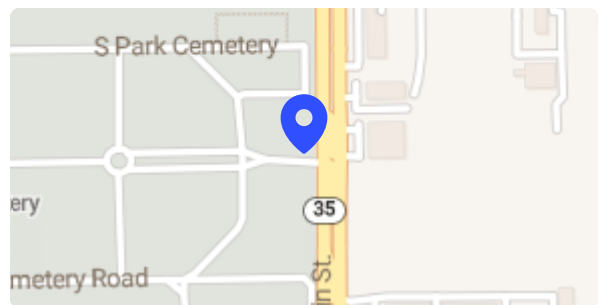

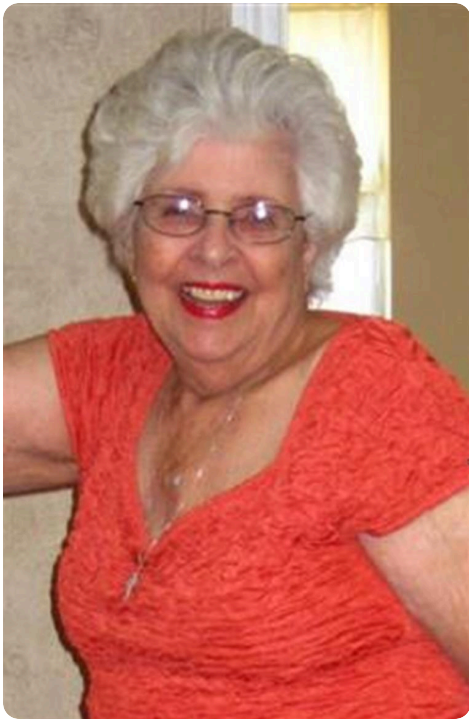
