and at the hour of our death.

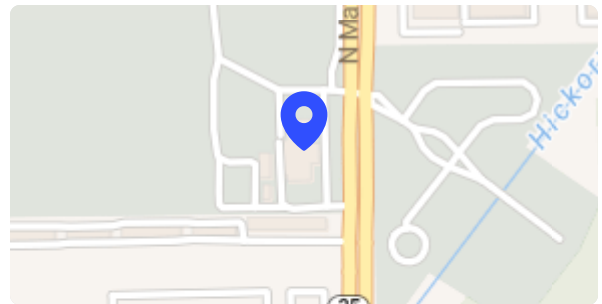
