**D**an D. Day was born David Dan Day on August 19, 1942 in Texarkana, Arkansas to David Estin Day and Lola Pauline Abel Day. He passed away surrounded by family at his home in Manvel, Texas on July 16, 2020 at the age of 77.

Dan grew up in the Museum District of Houston, Texas at 5218 La Branch where he attended McGregor Elementary, Johnston Junior High, and San Jacinto High School in Houston. Dan's first job was riding his bicycle delivering newspapers door to door. He then went to work at age 16 for Shine's Conoco Station on South Main Street in Houston where he worked all through high school. Dan joined the U.S. Navy after graduation from San Jacinto High School. When he returned to Houston Dan went to work for Houston Air Service for a short time. 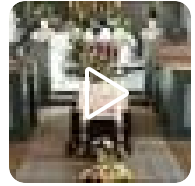
