Jimmy Don White, age 63 of Richmond, Texas passed away on August 8, 2020 from COVID-19. He is survived by his wife of 20 years Brenda Farley and sons Chris White and Nike White and step-sons Austin Darsey and David Darsey all from Houston Texas and sisters Patricia Ruth of Amarillo Texas and Perri Nance of Burleson Texas. Jim was preceded in death by his parents Jimmy Rolland White and Shirley Joe Johnson and sister Lee Ella 'Penny' Draper.

Jim was born in Abilene Texas on October 2, 1956 and grew up in Amarillo Texas where he graduated from Amarillo High School in 1974. When he became 18, he joined the United States Navy where he served at Quantico Naval Hospital. He was honorably discharged to enter college. 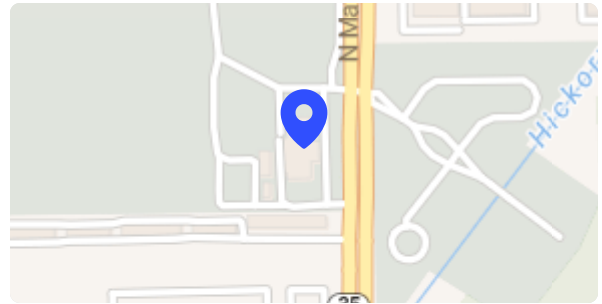

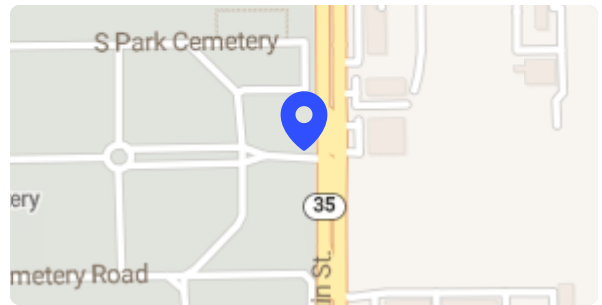
