Jesse Briones, age 87, passed away peacefully at home on February 1, 2021. He was born April 21, 1933 in Aldine, Texas to Simon Briones and his beloved wife Anselma Briones. Jesse was one of 7 children. The devout family lived in Houston, Texas.

Jesse graduated from Jeff Davis High School in 1952. He attended The University of Houston and other technical schools studying surveying, drafting, and structural design. He married the love of his life Marian Trujillo on June 3, 1956.

Jesse worked at the Port of Houston, Fluor Ocean Services, Conoco, and Dow Chemical.

Jesse is survived by Marian Briones (wife), daughters Debbie Milner (Steve), Lori Johnson (Dennis), Jessica Ross (Terry), and son Mario Briones (Kristie).
