**R**odolfo “Rudy” Inclan was born in Cotulla, TX on April 15, 1962. He passed away in his home on Tuesday, April 20th, 2021 surrounded by his loving wife and four beautiful daughters. Rudy was diagnosed with a rare Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma in March of 2016 and he bravely fought this disease for five years. His courageous battle ensured his family would be left with great memories of their time together and lots of love that they could carry with them after he was gone. He is preceded in death by his father, Juan Manuel Inclan, his mother, Elva Garcia Inclan, and his brother, Ramon G. Inclan.

He leaves behind his wife, Dianna Inclan and his four daughters, Miranda (and husband Paul) Gonzales, Amanda Moreno, Mercedes (and husband Adrian) Ochoa, and Arianna Inclan. He will also be missed by his five grandchildren, Aiden and Baby Gonzalez, Jayla and Leah Moreno, and Raelynn Ochoa. 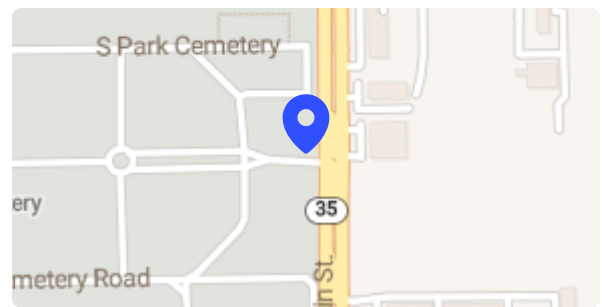
