**M**ichael “Mike” Bret Lindamood, age 69, of Pearland, Texas passed away in his home surrounded by loved ones on December 10, 2021 after a long battle with cancer.

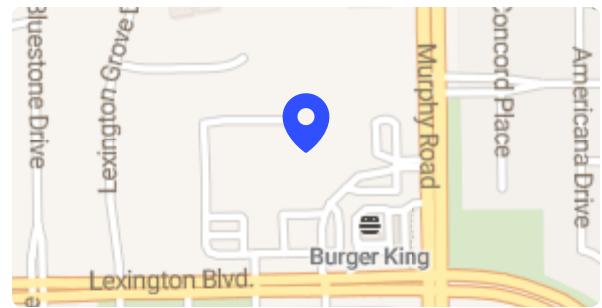
