Tarry graduated from Milby High School in 1953, a proud member of the Drum and Bugle Corps. She became a licensed radiology technician at Hermann Hospital. She met her husband Jack on a blind date and within a year, they married on December 13, 1958. Tarry's favorites were her family, her friends, books, genealogy, and gambling, not necessarily in that order. The gambling bug bit her after winning the \$20,000.00 jackpot in a Las Vegas slot tournament years ago. She and Jack traveled throughout the United States as well as Europe. New Orleans and Las Vegas were two of her favorite destinations and family joined her on numerous occasions. She was left wheelchair bound with limited speech capabilities. For 8 years, she managed her disabilities quite independently with style and grace. 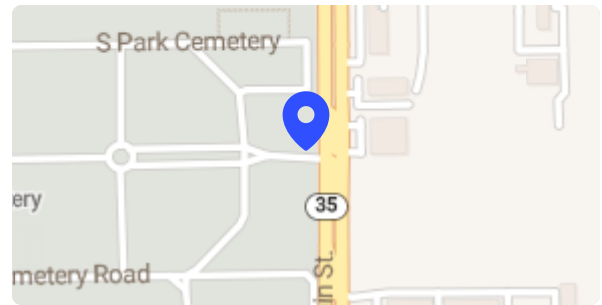
