In lieu of flowers, memorial donations may be made toward funeral expenses.



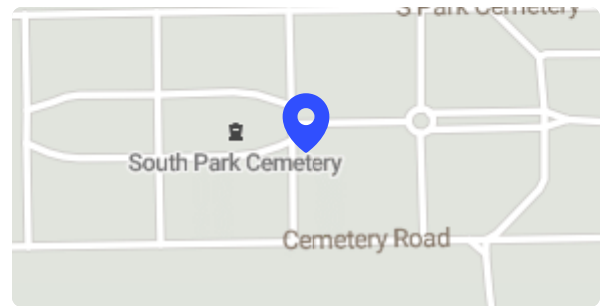

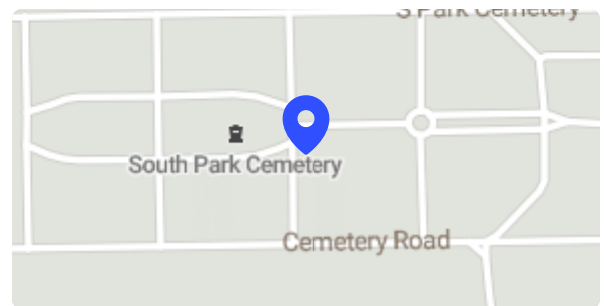
