Geneva Gillie Harrison, 81 years old of Sugar Land, Texas passed away on December 28, 2022 at 8:40 pm in a 10 year battle with Alzheimer's and Dementia. 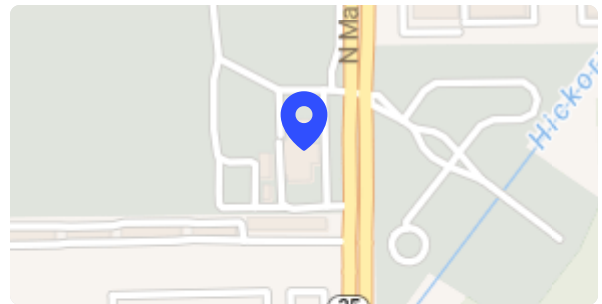

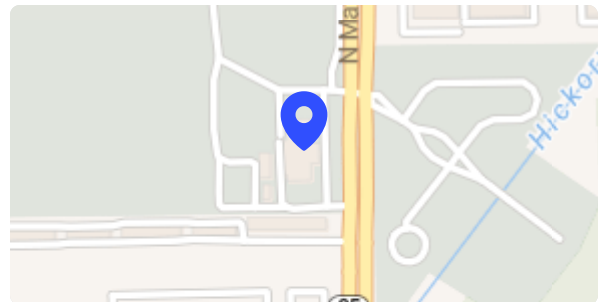

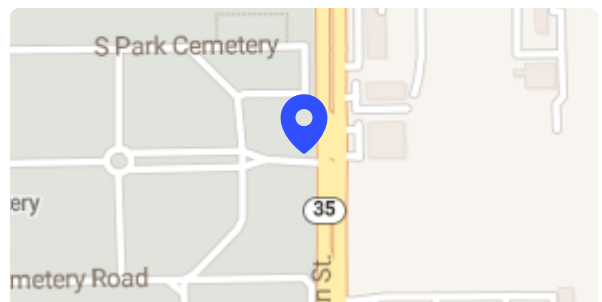
