Jesse enjoyed spending time with his children, grandchildren and his great grandchild. He always had a good story to tell and recollected his family history often.






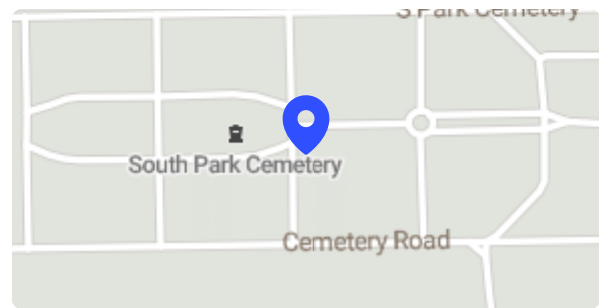

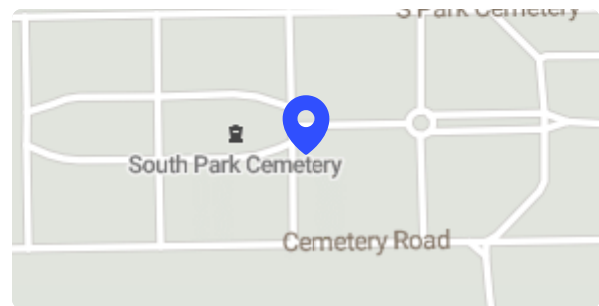
