In lieu of flowers, the family asks that donations be made to St. Jude Children's Charity in Frank's name.

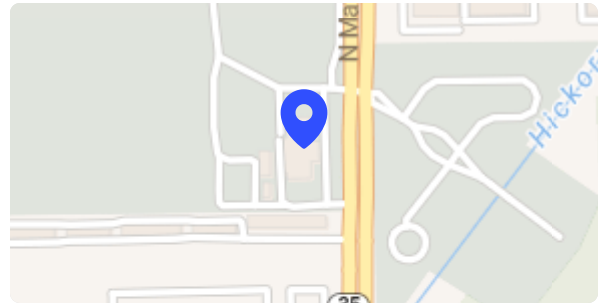
