We close this obituary with one of Estela's quotes she would say every night "Hasta mañana, si Dios quiere. "

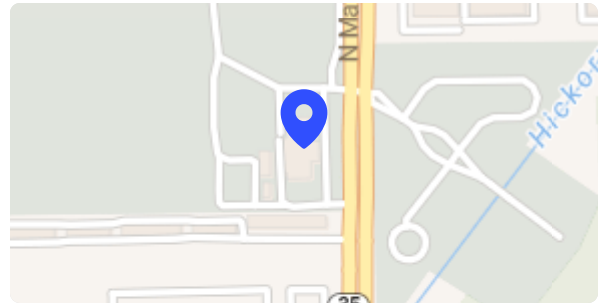
