Desiderio ahora descansa en los brazos del Señor.

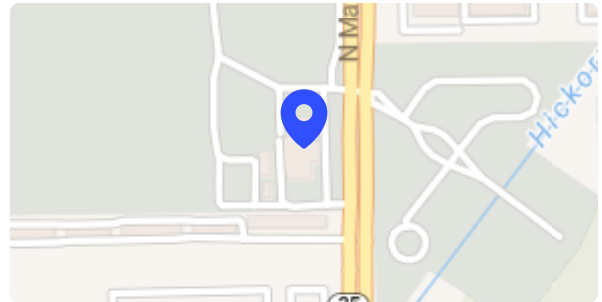

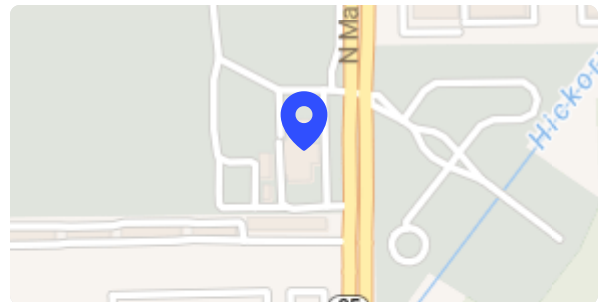

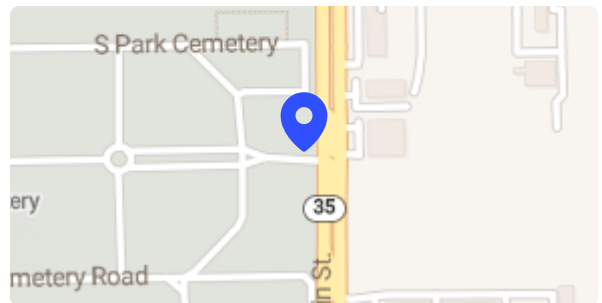
