Barbara Lee Barschow (Dutney), 83, of Pearland Texas, passed away on November 28, 2023, peacefully at home.

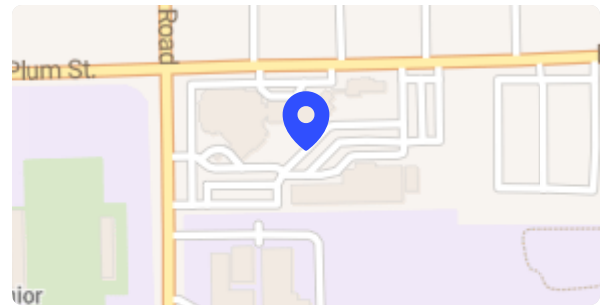

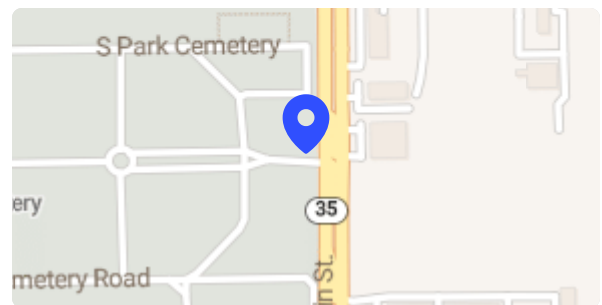
