She will be dearly missed but forever in our hearts.

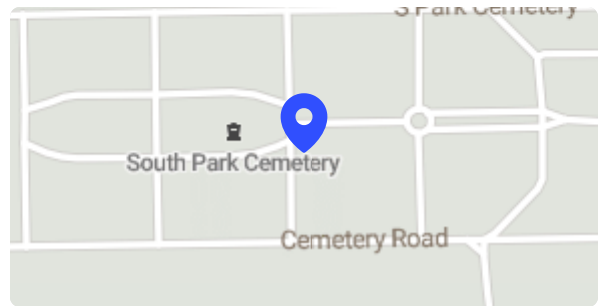

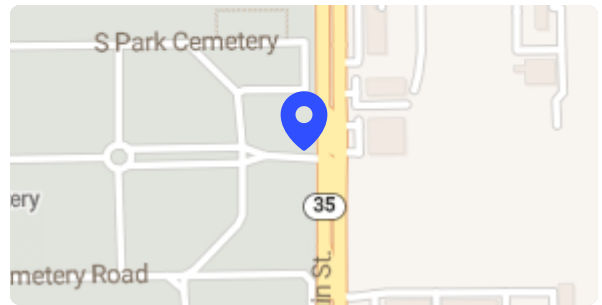
