Paulette married her husband; Ronald V. Dalton Sr, in 1963. She graduated Reagan High School in 1965 and was a stay at home mom until she went to work as a manager for a small hotel in Houston for 20 years. Afterwards she went to work for Bayshore Hospital in the food services, taking care of new mothers in the maternity ward. 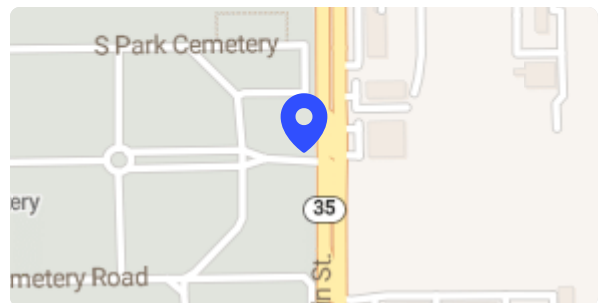

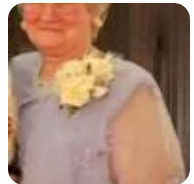
