A 17-year veteran of law enforcement, Jesse dedicated his life to serving and protecting the community he loved. Jesse is a hero to both his family and his community.

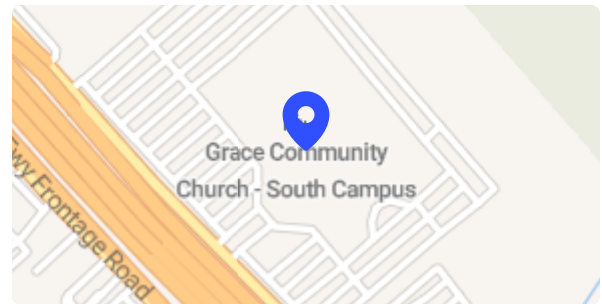

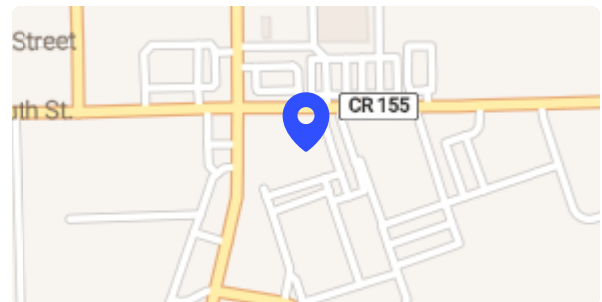

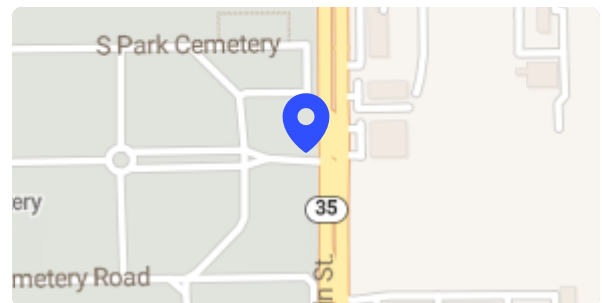
