Washington.

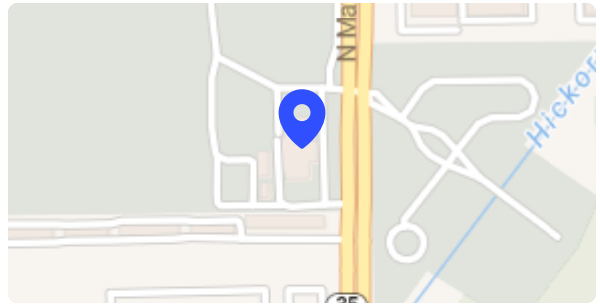

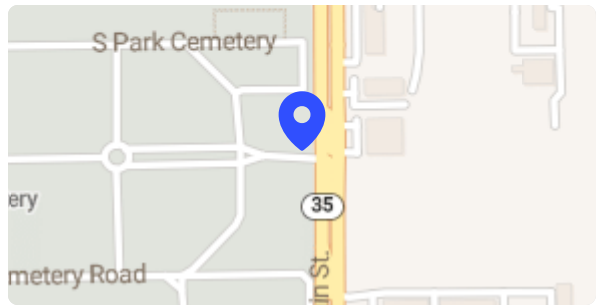

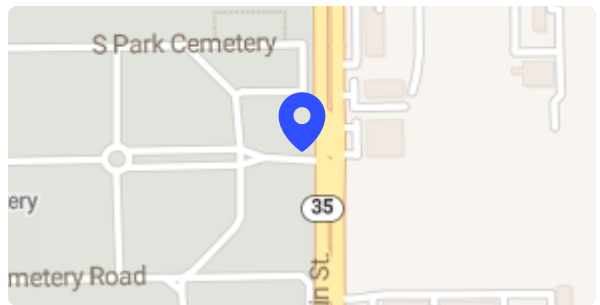
