Rest in peace, Lonnie Doyle Roe. Your love and guidance will remain with us always.

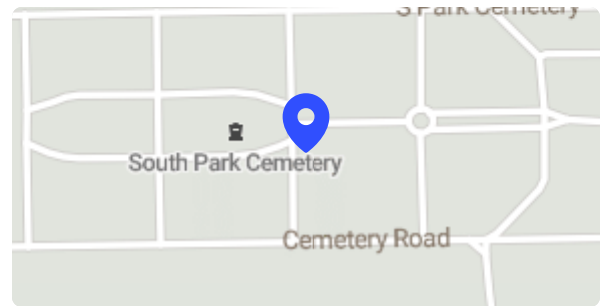
