Adam deeply loved the Soza, Aguilar and Ovalle families and held a special place in his heart for each of them along with the countless dear friends.

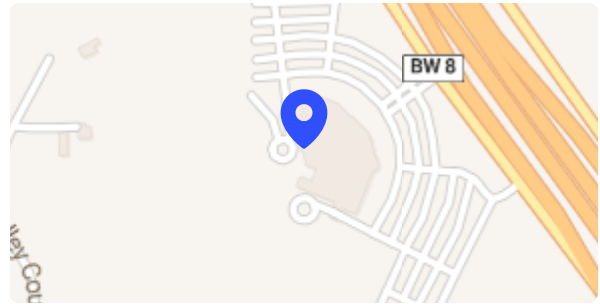

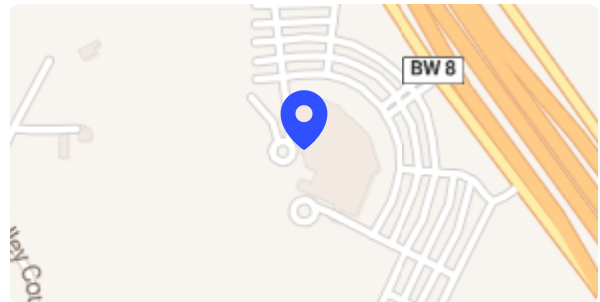

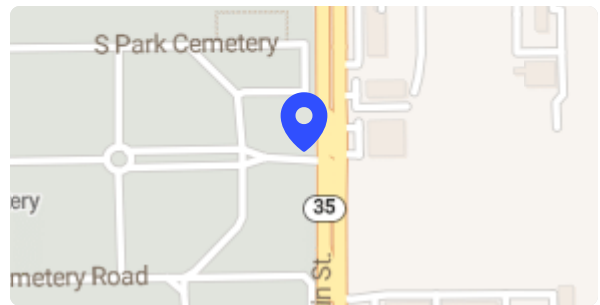
