MAY 21, 1950 - MAY 6, 2025

Reynaldo Acuña Martinez, 74, of Houston, Texas, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Tuesday night, May 6, 2025 at MD Anderson due to complications from his years-long, brave and courageous battle with leukemia.

Reynaldo was born in Tierras Coloradas, San Luis Potosi, Mexico on May 21, 1950.

His formal education was limited to elementary school in order to help his parents with their farm and his siblings. He came to the United States when he was 18 years old and became a proud naturalized citizen in 1990. Reynaldo married Alba Galvez from Veracruz, Mexico on December 12, 1976 in Houston. He was a parishioner of St. Benedict the Abbot Catholic Church and later transferred to Holy Family Catholic Church in Missouri City, when the family moved to Stafford, TX.

He worked as a machinist for Ladish Company and later worked for Schumacher-Dixie until his retirement. Any of Reynaldo's spare time was devoted to lovingly spending time with his family, cooking (famous for his gorditas, tamales & "surprise" tacos), as well as listening to music and working, and being outdoors. Over the years, he was involved in the Catholic Christian Family Movement (Movimiento Familiar Cristiano Catolico), a member of Nocturnal Adoration (Adoración Nocturna), and served in the Men's ACTS retreats in various capacities, including Director.

He is survived by his wife Alba (Galvez); daughter Edna; sons Eric and wife Jessica ; Edgar and wife Kristen; grandchildren Alexis, Eric Reynaldo Jr., Chantelle, Fidel, and great-grandson Jackson McCarthy.

Reynaldo is preceded in death by his parents, Joaquin & Apolonia Martinez, and his eldest sister, Ana Solis.

Reynaldo Acuña Martínez, de 74 años, de Houston, Texas, falleció en paz rodeado de su familia el martes por la noche, 6 de mayo de 2025 en MD Anderson debido a complicaciones de su valiente y prolongada batalla contra la leucemia.

Reynaldo nació en Tierras Coloradas, San Luis Potosí, México el 21 de mayo de 1950.

Su educación formal se limitó a la escuela primaria para ayudar a sus padres con su rancho y con sus hermanos. Llegó a los Estados Unidos a los 18 años y orgullosamente se hizo ciudadano en 1990. Reynaldo se casó con Alba Gálvez, de Veracruz, México, el 12 de diciembre de 1976 en Houston. Fue feligrés de la Iglesia Católica de San Benedicto y posteriormente se trasladó a la Iglesia Católica de la Sagrada Familia en Missouri City, cuando la familia se mudó a Stafford, Texas.

Trabajó como maquinista para la compañía de Ladish y posteriormente trabajó para Schumacher-Dixie hasta su jubilación. Todo el tiempo libre de Reynaldo lo dedicaba a pasar tiempo amorosamente con su familia, a cocinar (famoso por sus gorditas, tamales y tacos “sorpresa”), así como a escuchar música, trabajar afuera en la yarda o terreno. A lo largo de los años, participó en el Movimiento Familiar Cristiano Católico, fue miembro de Adoración Nocturna y participó en los retiros de hombres de ACTS en diversos cargos, incluyendo el de director.

Le sobreviven su esposa Alba (Gálvez); su hija Edna; sus hijos Eric y su esposa Jessica; Edgar y su esposa Kristen; sus nietos Alexis, Eric Reynaldo Jr., Chantelle, Fidel y su bisnieto Jackson McCarthy.
