May Maria Elena's soul rest in eternal peace. She will forever be loved, always remembered, and never forgotten.



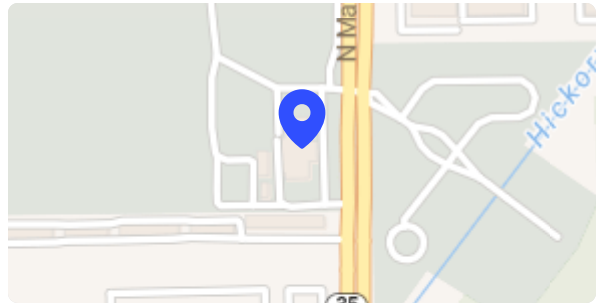
