Steve will be missed by all who knew and loved him. In lieu of flowers please donate to the St Jude's Children's Cancer Research Fund.



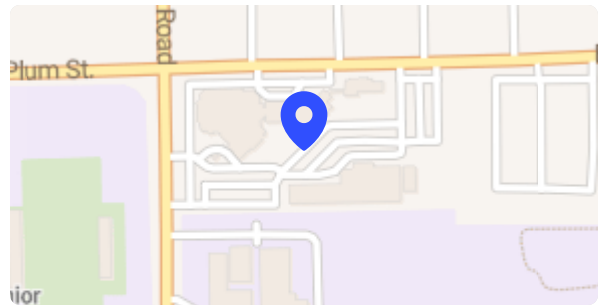
