She will be deeply missed and forever remembered.






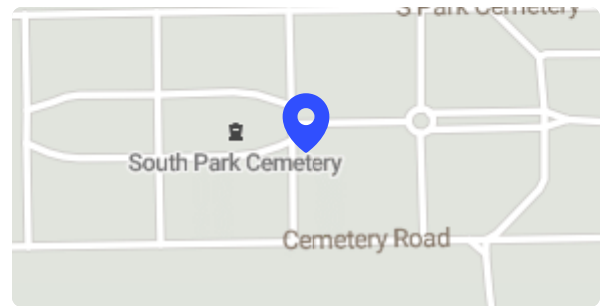

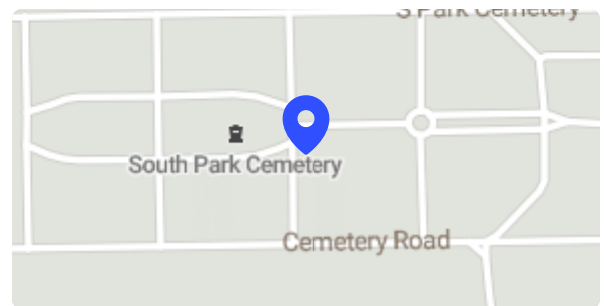

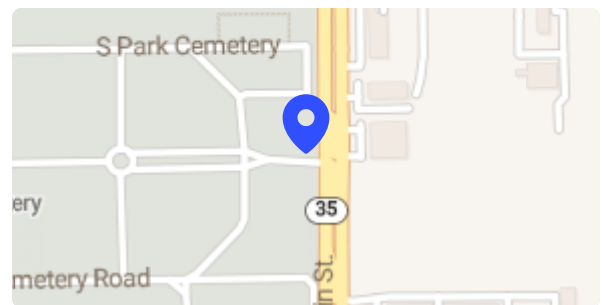
