## Obituary for Jo Ann Hall

Jo Ann Boles Hall of Trinity, TX, passed away on February 2, 2026. She was born in Marshall, TX, to Guy Tucker Boles and Mary Leta (Morris) Boles on July 16, 1934.

She worked at Roseboro & Burns Insurance Company, then at McClain's Insurance in Marshall, and later at Lee Russell Insurance in Houston, before retiring in the 1970's to be a full-time homemaker for her family. 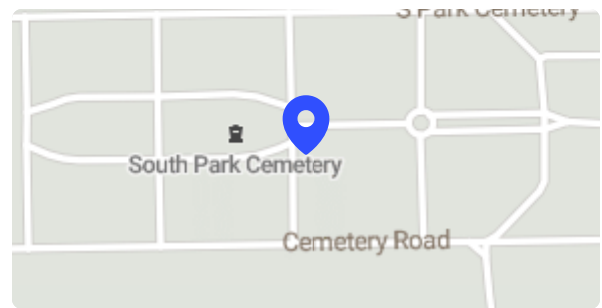

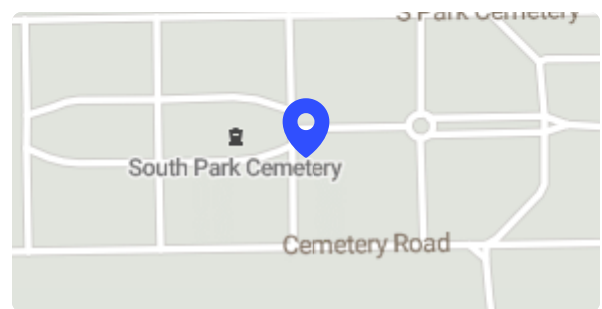

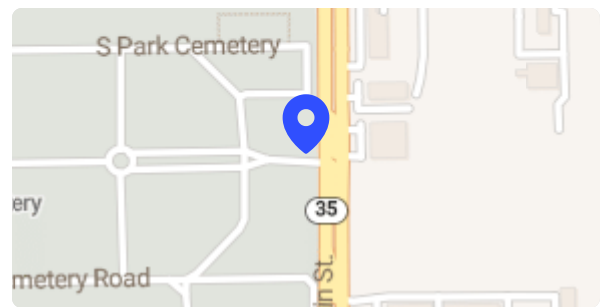
