James “Bud” Foshee, age 89, of Pearland, Texas passed away peacefully on April 13, 2026. He was born February 21, 1937, in Port Arthur, Texas.

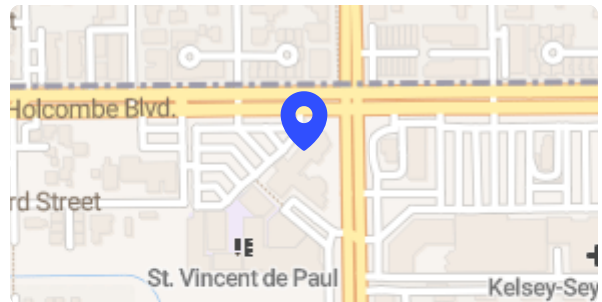

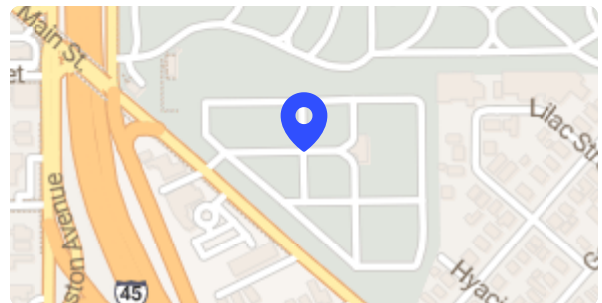

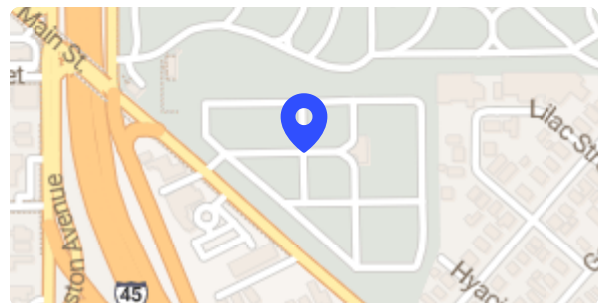
