Her dance continues in the hearts of all who loved her.

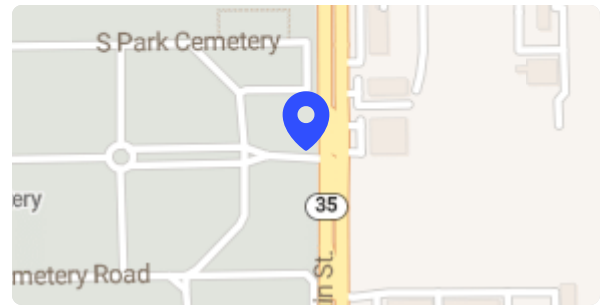

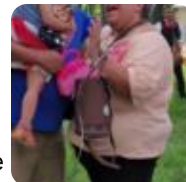
